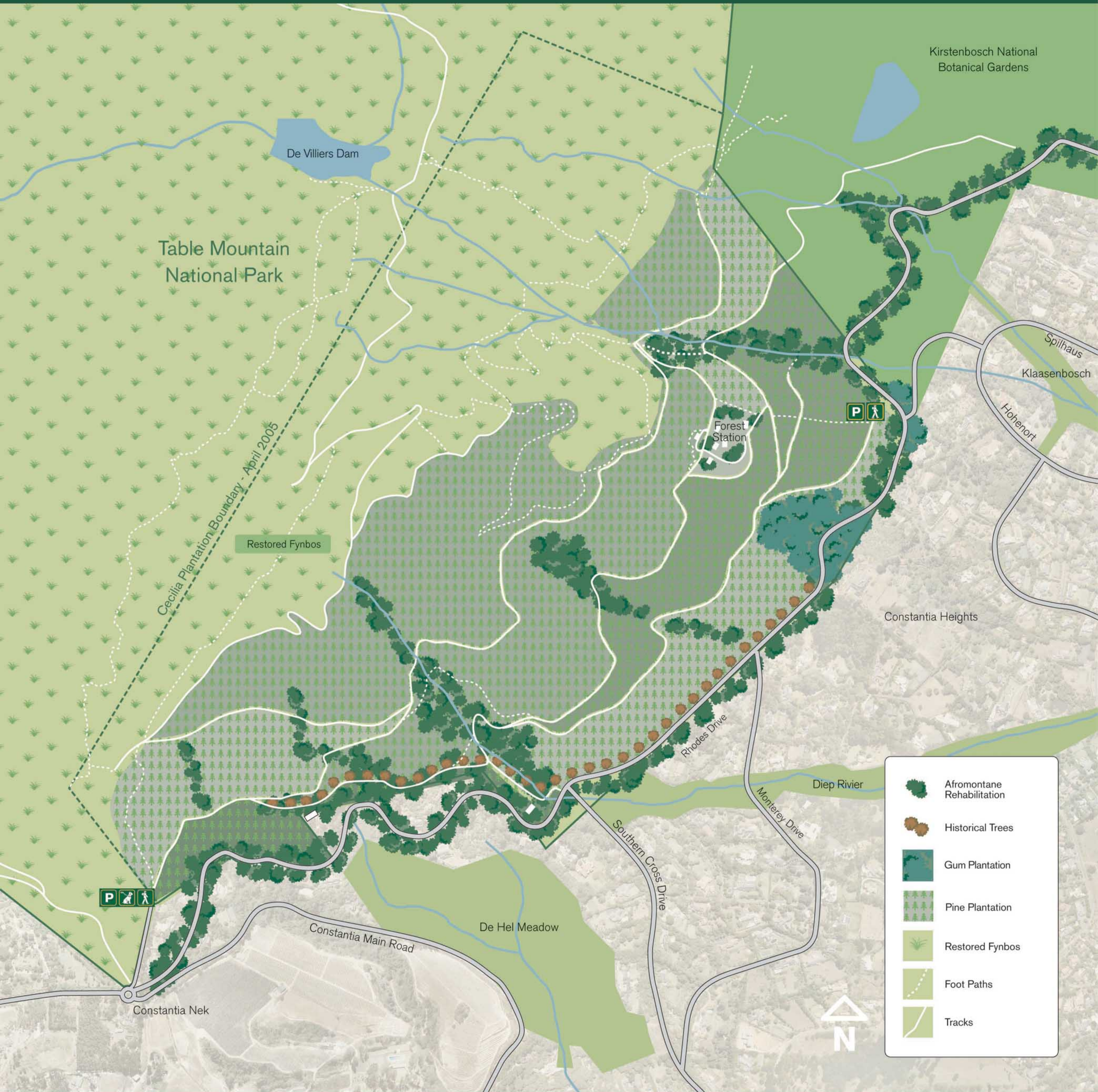


Cecilia Plantation

In February 2005, South African National Parks (SANParks) was 'assigned' by Dept. of Water Affairs and Forestry (DWAF) the management of the Tokai and Cecilia plantations as part of the Table Mountain National Park (TMNP). This was in line with the original Government and City Council decision in 1997 to establish a National Park in the Cape Peninsula

Protected Natural Environment (CPPNE). The key challenge faced by SANParks is to manage the transition of Tokai and Cecilia from a commercial plantation to a National Park whilst finding a balance between biodiversity, recreation and heritage requirements in the context of an urban environment.
